

Supervisory Training

for Drug and Alcohol Testing

Our goal is to help make workplaces safer for your employees.

If your company has implemented a Drug-Free Workplace program that includes testing or if you fall under the Federal Department of Transportation Regulations, we can help you meet the mandatory training requirements.

Iowa Code 730.5: All supervisory personnel involved with drug or alcohol testing shall attend a minimum of two hours of initial training and on an annual basis thereafter, a minimum of one hour subsequent training.

According to the Omnibus Testing Act: Each employer shall ensure that persons designated to determine whether reasonable suspicion exists to require a driver to undergo testing must receive at least 60 minutes of training on alcohol misuse and receive an additional 60 minutes of training on controlled substance use. This training shall cover the physical, behavioral, speech, and performance indicators of probable alcohol misuse and use of controlled substances

The Supervisor Training is on-demand training only and you may register by clicking on the link below.

We want to ensure all supervisors understand their specific responsibilities for initiating and carrying out the drug-free workplace policy and program. Supervisors should receive training on how to recognize and deal with employees who have job performance, personal, and family problems that could be related to alcohol or other drugs.

- 1-Hour Supervisor Annual Training - \$20/person
