To be eligible for the **MercyOne Patrick and Anna McKay Scholarship**, an applicant must:

- ☐ Be employed by MercyOne Clinton or related to an employee.
- ☐ Be pursuing education in a health care field and apply scholarship funds to education costs.
- ☐ Complete the **Application Form**.
- ☐ Provide three forms of recommendation using the **Scholarship Reference Form**. The Educational Assistance Program with MercyOne Clinton Medical Center may be used for tuition only.
- ☐ If you are eligible for Educational Assistance, you must submit all of your receipts including any tuition, fees, or books at the end of each semester, prior to receiving any reimbursement, to the Human Resource office.
- ☐ The total Scholarship/Educational Assistance Program combined is not to exceed the total cost of tuition, fees, and books.

**Incomplete applications are subject to disqualification.**

Selection of scholarship recipients will not be based on sex, age, race, color, national origin, disability, marital status or religion.
